A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING SATURDAY, APRIL 27, 2013, AS NORMAN MUSIC FESTIVAL DAY IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, arts and culture flourish alongside academia and sports within the City of Norman; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, as a result of the 2012 Norman Music Festival, \$3.6 million in new monies were generated for Norman and the surrounding communities; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, Norman is currently involved in a downtown revitalization project that will guide Norman and its citizens into the 21st Century; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the City of Norman is known as the City of Festivals by the State of Oklahoma; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, the City of Norman has a strong sense of community, a high quality of life and affordability, and appreciation for diversity, the arts, and culture; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, the City of Norman was the first city in the State of Oklahoma to offer a free independent music festival for all ages to enjoy.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 7. Do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 27, 2013, as Norman Music Festival Day in the City of Norman and urge all citizens of Norman to consider attending this festival with friends and family and help grow the tourism and economy in the City of Norman.
