Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$138.5 million as of 08/31/12 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$ 67.23 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$30.1 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$21.46, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$9.38 million, NMA bond proceeds of \$3.94 million, and UNP TIF reserve amounts of \$6.39 million.
