A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2014, AS NATIONAL RECOVERY MONTH IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, behavioral health is an essential part of health and one's overall wellness and preventing and overcoming mental and/or substance use disorders is essential to achieving healthy lifestyles, both physically and emotionally; and

- § 5. WHEREAS, Norman Alcohol Addiction Information Center (NAIC) provides help and inspires hope for individuals, families, and communities through the prevention and treatment of addiction and mental illness; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, Thunderbird Clubhouse works to create a new future for adults recovering from mental illness through the positive power of meaningful work, community, choice and hopes; and
- § 7. WHEREAS, Thousands of Oklahomans suffer from depression, dependence issues and a host of other behavioral concerns and Norman Regional Health Systems has provided multi-disciplinary, confidential care for more than 29 years to those who need it.
