Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$168.81 million as of 03/31/15 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$42.07 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$66.10 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$18.32 million, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$5.29 million, NMA bond proceeds of \$23.59 million, and UNP TIF reserve amounts of \$13.44 million.

Only in exceptional circumstances would securities be sold before their maturity, due to cash flow demands or favorable market conditions.
