Oklahoma Natural Gas Company **does have** facilities [2" PE 051.2990.010545] with an in service date of 2016. This main line does lay within the proposed encroachment in the 10' utility easement. The above mentioned location is in a part of the NE/4 Section 22, Township 9 North, and Range 3 West of the Indian Meridian.

Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a division of ONE Gas, Inc., does not object to the request to encroach with the personal driveway. However, ONG is not responsible for any maintenance damages from leak surveys or any access to this pipeline. The lines, easements and pursuant to the provisions of 11 O.S. 2011 §42-105, Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a division of ONE Gas, Inc., shall retain and continue to have an easement and unrestricted ingress and egress within, beneath and across such street, avenue and/or alley to continue to enter upon, possess, occupy, maintain, operate, use, repair, upgrade, replace, reconstruct and remove its facilities therein and to continue to operate and provide such services in the performance of its public service undertaking, pursuant to instruments of record, including easements, franchise agreements, etc.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORK:** 

Approval to encroach in an U/E along the north lot line

LEGALS OF WORK LOCATION: 2109 Brookhaven Boulevard

Lot 1, Block 3, Brookhaven No. 40 Addition

Mr. Nixon;

Your request for approval from Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company (OG&E) to install concrete paving over the platted utility easement located along the north lot line, has been reviewed. Our records indicate OG&E has nothing in this utility easement, but we do have a pedestal located near the northeast corner of this lot. The pedestal is in a separate utility easement that intersects with the utility easement you wish to pave over. OG&E has primary underground lines running along the back or east side of this lot in the existing platted utility easement. Care will need to be taken not to disturb our pedestal or any other underground facilities we may have. OG&E does not object to the proposed work, provided, the applicant abides by all City of Norman guidelines, and does the following:

- 1.) Notify "Call-Okie" at (405) 840-5032 at least 48 hours before digging to have all lines marked.
- If equipment is involved and is as high as the lowest OG&E overhead wire, approximately 18 feet, and it will be
  operating within 10 feet of our wire, you should call OG&E construction at
  553-5143, to have wires covered.
- 3.) Call OG&E construction at 553-5143 two days before drilling and/or trenching closer than ten feet to an OG&E utility pole and/or wire, or five feet to an OG&E underground line.
- 4.) OG&E would not be held responsible for damaging a private line in a (public/platted) easement.
- 5.) OG&E would need to be reimbursed for any damage to its facilities.

6.) OG&E would need to be reimbursed ahead of time for the cost of relocating any facilities.

Should local service be disrupted to any OG&E customer due to the work performed by you and/or your contractors, both parties will be responsible for any costs incurred by OG&E to restore service. Obtaining approval from the city of Norman, or beginning the above referenced work constitutes acceptance of the terms of this letter.
