**BACKGROUND**: In June 2017, the Office of Emergency Management applied for and was approved to receive a grant from the Office of Homeland Security to purchase a UbiDuo device to support the response capability for communication with hearing impaired residents.

**DISCUSSION**: During the Inter-Tribal Emergency Management Conference in 2016, the UbiDuo device was introduced to the participants. This device enables deaf/hard of hearing people to communicate with hearing

people without any barriers. The UbiDuo is a two-screen, two keyboard electronic communication device. It is completely portable, wireless, and operates in real-time. This device will support community events and response efforts by allowing responders and case managers the ability to communicate immediately to a deaf or hearing impaired resident.

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that City Council accept the grant, approve the contract in the amount of \$2,080 under the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Homeland Security Grant Program; deposit the funding into Other Revenue: Emergency Management Grant (account 022-0000-331.13-60) and appropriate funds into Minor Tools and Equipment (account 022-9508-422.36-10; project GF0075).
