A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING SUNDAY,
JUNE 1, 2014, AS 2014 SAM NOBLE MUSEUM
NATIONAL MEDAL DAY IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, Americans from all ranges of incomes and education visit museums and cultural centers; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, Americans view museums as one of the most important resources for educating our children and as one of the most trustworthy sources of objective information; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, Museums tell important stories by collecting, preserving, researching and interpreting objects, living specimens and historical records; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the Sam Noble Oklahoma Museum of Natural History shares a true partnership with the citizens of Norman and exists due to the collaborative efforts between the University of Oklahoma, the City of Norman, and the citizens of Norman; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, the Sam Noble Oklahoma Museum of Natural History has been recognized as the first Oklahoma institution to receive the National Medal for Museums and Libraries.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 6. Do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 1, 2014, as 2014 Sam Noble Museum National Medal Day in the City of Norman, Oklahoma, and urge all citizens to observe this day by taking time to recognize and acknowledge the important roles of the Sam Noble Museum in the lives of our community members.
