INFORMATION: Kathryn Schwartz will fill the vacancy left by Michelle Carey who is no longer eligible to serve. William Scanlon will fill the vacancy for Ward Six.

City Council adopted Resolution R-1415-11 on July 8, 2014, creating the University North Park Business Improvement District (BID). As outlined in the Assessment Roll, the Authority shall establish an advisory board to assist in administering all aspects of the Business Improvement District. Members of the advisory board shall include nine (9) members which will include two (2) representatives from the hospitality Industry with a

business location within the BID District appointed by the General Manager of Embassy Suites; two (2) representatives from the retail industry who own property or have a retail business in the BID District appointed by University Town Center; one (1) representative appointed by UNP, L.L.C., or the entity that owns the largest percentage of property within the BID District being utilized for non-retail commercial or residential purposes; and four (4) representatives nominated by the Mayor and confirmed by a majority of City Council.
