

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AUTHORIZING AND APPOINTING FREDGREN QUALITY WORKS AS PROJECT AGENT FOR THE HISTORICAL MUSEUM CARRIAGE HOUSE RENOVATION PROJECT.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma, does hereby acknowledge that the tax-exempt status of this political subdivision is a significant factor in determining the agreed contract price bid by Fredgren Quality Works for the Historical Museum Carriage House Renovation Project; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma, in compliance with State law, desires to confer on by Fredgren Quality Works its special State and Federal sales tax exemptions and in order to achieve such end, finds it necessary to appoint as its direct purchasing agent, by Fredgren Quality Works to purchase materials which are in fact used for the Historical Museum Carriage House Renovation Project; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, this limited agent status is conferred with the express understanding that by Fredgren Quality Works shall appoint employees and subcontractors as subagents who shall be authorized to make purchases on their behalf.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 4. That the City of Norman, Oklahoma, on the 11th day of March, 2014, did appoint Fredgren Quality Works who is involved the Historical Museum Carriage House Renovation Project, an agent of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, solely for the purpose of purchasing, on a tax-exempt basis, materials and tangible personal property to be used exclusively for the Historical Museum Carriage House Renovation Project.
