A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, EXTENDING APPRECIATION TO CHAD WILLIAMS FOR SERVING AS WARD EIGHT COUNCILMEMBER IN NORMAN, OKLAHOMA.

- § 7. WHEREAS, Chad Williams served on the Community Planning and Transportation Committee, the Business and Community Affairs Committee, and the Oversight Committee
- § 8. WHEREAS, Chad Williams is an advocate for the business community and supported streamlining the building and development process for applicants who were building a new place of business, expanding their present location, or relocating their establishment.
