Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$244.74 million as of 05/31/20 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$95.24 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$46.53 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$38.89 million, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$12.21 million. NMA bond proceeds of \$31.73 million, and UNP TIF reserve amounts of \$20.14 million.
