**BACKGROUND:** The City of Norman Citizens CORPS Council, administered by the Office of Emergency Management, participates with the Oklahoma Medical Reserve CORPS as the administrator for the Cleveland County Medical Reserve CORPS. During a recent application period Norman Emergency Management, as Coordinator for the Cleveland County Medical Reserve CORPS, applied for and received approval of a grant from the National Association of County and City Health Officials. City Council approved the grant agreement, Contract K-1415-105 on February 10, 2015. The funding was used to support the operations of the Cleveland County Medical Reserve CORPS during the 2015 Medieval Fair.

**DISCUSSION:** Due to the Division of Civilian Volunteer Medical Reserve Corps' transition from the Office of the Surgeon General (OSG) to the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR), the National Association of County and City Health Officials, (NACCHO) has submitted an Amendment to the Contract changing the funding source to the Department of Health and Human Services and changing the grant number assigned by the Federal Government. Please note, none of the terms and conditions of the agreement are changing. The only modification to the original agreement is the Grant Number.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Based on the above and foregoing discussion, Staff recommends that the City Council approve Amendment No. One to K-1415-105 with NACCHO.
