Now on this 14th day of MARCH, 2017, the Court finds that due to SCRIVENER'S ERROR Paragraph 10 of the order entered herein on MARCH 6, 2017, should be and the same is hereby vacated and the following entered in lieu thereof:

THAT Respondent shall pay court costs; Special Occupational Health and Safety Fund Tax of three-fourths of one percent (0.75%) of the amounts paid in lump sum of \$181.69. Pursuant to 85 O.S., Section 407, as amended by Laws 2013, HB 2201, c. 254, Section 49, eff. January 1, 2015, Respondent, if Own Risk, shall pay \$484.50 to the Workers' Compensation Administration Fund created by 85 O.S. Section 407, to be used for the costs of administering the Workers' Compensation Code as applicable to the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court of Existing Claims, representing two percent (2%) of the permanent disability award herein.

This order corrects nunc pro tunc the order entered herein on MARCH 6, 2017, and all other provisions of said order shall remain in full force and effect as the order of this Court.
