It is currently an eye-sore and if re-zoned Kappa Alpha Theta will buy it and turn it into a well-maintained parking lot which plenty of landscaping. Hello Ellen,

I am an Alpha Omicron alumna of Kappa Alpha Theta and had served on the Facility Corporation for many years before rolling off in November 2019. The importance of 748 College in relation to the Theta house at 845 Chautauqua is pretty understandable. Like most sororities and fraternities in that area, we are landlocked. This offers us the opportunity to expand and upgrade our location that we have had for over 80 years.

The information coming from neighbors was that the property would be maintained and blend well with the surrounding area. I think that it is important to understand how the sorority and the Facility Corporation work so that any concerns about the care of the property can be alleviated. The Facility Corporation, which will be buying the property, is a non-profit made up of the alumni of the Theta house and own the property at 845 Chautauqua. The board are volunteers and the corporation has its own set of bylaws and policies and procedures to follow. We have operated this way for as long as the Thetas have been on campus. The sorority, the active members of Kappa Alpha Theta that are enrolled at OU, live in the house and pay what we call "house bills" to the sorority. The sorority pays the Facility Corporation "rent" to maintain the house and grounds as well as cover insurance costs and remodeling and redecorating expenses. The maintenance of the property or properties is in the hands of the Facility Corporation and they are dedicated and committed to keeping the grounds and house in outstanding condition. We have a board member that serves as Grounds Chairman that works with a local landscaper, lawn company, sprinkler company and when needed, a local arborist to maintain the trees on the property. The grounds are meticulously taken care of and will continue to be.

I hope this helps to clarify any concerns about the property going to a sorority.
