BACKGROUND: The Norman Animal Welfare submitted a grant request to fund the purchase of martingale collars and other supplies that will be used to facilitate play groups for adoptable dogs at the Norman Animal Shelter. Maddie's Fund is a foundation dedicated to revolutionizing the status and well-being of companion animals. The grant is identified specifically to be used in support of the Norman Animal Welfare's project titled "Collars of a Different Color". This project will both engage volunteers and provide needed social enrichment for adoptable dogs, thereby reducing length of stay and guaranteeing a well-adjusted healthy pet.
