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BACKGROUND: In October 2015, the Office of Emergency Management applied for and was approved to receive a grant from the Office of Homeland Security to support the Norman Citizens CORPS volunteer programs.

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> During October 2015, the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security provided a notice of funding availability for local Citizen CORPS programs. Norman Emergency Management applied for and received approval for equipment needed by the Norman Emergency Response Volunteers and the Cleveland County

Medical Reserve CORPS (MRC) to support community events and disaster response. The grant allows for the purchase of a large, enclosed equipment trailer; display items for community outreach and education; improved computer storage capability; and MRC responder backpacks.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that City Council accept the grant in the amount of \$21,995 under the FY2014 Homeland Security Grant Program; receipt into the Special Grants Fund, Other Revenue: Emergency Management Grant (account 022-0000-331.13-60) and appropriate funds as follows:

Other Supplies/Materials/Miscellaneous (022-9508-422.31-99) \$600 Uniform & Clothing/Wearing Apparel (022-9508-422.35-03) \$150 Minor Equipment & Tools (022-9508-422.36-10) \$1,055 Miscellaneous Services/Express & Freight (022-9508-422.47-02) \$150 Service Equipment/Trailers (022-9508-422.50-10) \$20,000
