A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, ESTABLISHING THE NINE-ONE-ONE EMERGENCY TELEPHONE FEE RATE FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2014.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the voters and/or the governing body of the City of Norman have approved the acquisition and operation of an emergency telephone service, together with the levy or imposition of a user fee/tax for such service; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, said approving authority, service, and fee are authorized pursuant to the Nine-One-One Emergency Number Act, 63 O.S. Supp. 1987, §2811 et. seq., as amended; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, §2814 of said act authorizes the imposition of a telephone fee not-to-exceed five percent (5%) of the first twelve months of collections and three percent (3%) thereafter of the tariff rate for telephone service to support said emergency telephone service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 4. That it does, by this action, hereby establish the rate for the Nine-One-One Emergency Telephone Service fee for the calendar year 2014 at three percent (3%) of the recurring charges as designated by the tariff for exchange telephone service or its equivalent within said City in accordance with said Act beginning January 1, 2014.
