

434 South Chautauqua Avenue. Ca. 1920. Colonial Revival. This contributing, two-story, weatherboard and wood shingles single dwelling has an asphalt-covered, side-gambrel roof with cross-gables and a decorative concrete block foundation. The wood windows are vertical, four- and five-over-one, hung. The wood door is glazed paneled. The partial porch has been screened. Setback on the south side is a sun porch topped by a wood balustrade, creating a second floor porch area. Decorative details include double and triple windows. To the rear is a single car, weatherboard garage with a front-gabled, asphalt-covered roof and a paneled overhead door.
