

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, CLOSING A PART OF A TWENTY (20) FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY (ALLEY) LOCATED IN BLOCK FIVE (5) OF FRANKLIN ADDITION TO NORMAN, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 1. That, pursuant to Resolution Number R-8081-66, Franklin Baptist Church, owner of the subject property, has petitioned the City to have part of a twenty foot (20') right-of-way (alley) within Block 5, FRANKLIN ADDITION, closed; and
- § 2. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8081-66, the proper notice has been given, and the maps, memorandums and other items required by said Resolution have been presented to this Council; and
- § 3. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8081-66, a public hearing has been held regarding said closing; and
- § 4. That, the twenty foot (20') right-of-way (alley) between Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13 and Lots 29, 30, 31, and 32 in Block 5 of Franklin Addition to Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, is hereby closed.
- § 5. Severability: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
