

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AUTHORIZING AND APPOINTING H & H PLUMBING & UTILITIES, INC., AS PROJECT AGENT FOR THE 24TH AVENUE EAST WATER LINE RELOCATION PROJECT, PHASE 2.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma, does hereby acknowledge that the tax-exempt status of this political subdivision is a significant factor in determining the agreed contract price bid by H & H Plumbing & Utilities, Inc., for the 24th Avenue East Water Line Relocation Project; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma, in compliance with State law, desires to confer on H & H Plumbing & Utilities, Inc., its special State and Federal sales tax exemptions and in order to achieve such end, finds it necessary to appoint as its direct purchasing agent, H & H Plumbing & Utilities, Inc., to purchase materials which are in fact used for the 24th Avenue East Water Line Relocation Project; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, this limited agent status is conferred with the express understanding that H & H Plumbing & Utilities, Inc., shall appoint employees and subcontractors as subagents who shall be authorized to make purchases on their behalf.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 4. That the City of Norman, Oklahoma, on the 12th day of February, 2019, did appoint H & H Plumbing & Utilities, Inc., who is involved in the 24th Avenue East Water Line Relocation Project, as an agent of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, solely for the purpose of purchasing, on a tax-exempt basis, materials and tangible personal property to be used exclusively for the 24th Avenue East Water Line Relocation Project.
