

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING THE STREET NAME CHANGE PORTION OF THE CITIZENS RECOGNITION POLICY FOR THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the Citizens Recognition Policy adopted in 2008 by Resolution R-0809-60 contains a section that governs permanently changing the name of a current street; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the procedure for permanently changing a current street name adopted in in Resolution R-0809-60 requires a petition containing signatures of at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the property owners adjacent to the street being changed and payment of a \$200 application fee; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, City Council has requested an amendment to the procedure for permanently changing a current street name adopted in Resolution R-0809-60 that gives City Council some flexibility if the name of a current street name is determined to be offensive or derogatory as measured by the Civil Rights and anti-discrimination policy of the City set forth in Section 7-101(a) of the City's Code of Ordinances; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the Council Oversight Committee in its meeting on November 8, 2017, discussed and reviewed the amended Citizens Recognition Policy and recommends adoption of the policy; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, City Council in a study session on December 12, 2017, reviewed the amended Citizens Recognition Policy and indicated that amended Policy should be placed on an Agenda for formal approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 6. That the amended Citizens Recognition Policy, attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted to provide City Council some flexibility if the name of a current street name is determined to be offensive or derogatory as measured by the Civil Rights and anti-discrimination policy of the City set forth in Section 7-101(a) of the City's Code of Ordinances.
