Rates of return on these investments relate directly to current Treasury and Money Market rates. Total funds on deposit of \$173.46 million as of 03/31/13 are represented by working capital cash balances of all City funds of approximately \$82.61 million, outstanding encumbrances of \$34.72 million, General Obligation Bond proceeds of \$39.14 million, NUA revenue bond proceeds of \$8.69 million, NMA bond proceeds of \$828 thousand, and UNP TIF reserve amounts of \$7.47 million.
