#### **COUNCIL COMMENTS:**

Councilmember Bierman said Kyle Allison and Aleisha Karjala both served this community admirably and they brought skills and perspective to this Council. She said Kyle brought valuable insight in the committees that they shared together. She said she did not think that anyone cared as much as Aleisha about what she did. She looks forward to serving with Councilmembers Scott and Carter and looks forward to having two new perspectives.

Councilmember Carter thanked the Mayor for the opportunity to be here tonight and to join this fine group of people. He said he is looking forward to the challenges and ready to go to work.

Councilmember Castleberry said Aleisha Karjala was the Councilmember in the ward where he used to office. He said Kyle and he worked on a lot of joint issues as there wards were contiguous. He said Kyle came on Council at the same time as his first child was born and Aleisha was traveling back and forth to work in Chickasha. He said both served well even though they had a lot of time constraints. He said he looks forward to working with Councilmembers Carter and Scott.

Councilmember Hickman said sometimes people do not realize that Councilmembers are volunteers and it does take a fair amount of time and effort to serve the community. He said he appreciated Aleisha and Kyle's service to our community and wish them well in their future endeavors. He said he is excited to welcome Councilmembers Carter and Scott as part of the team and looks forward to the upcoming year.

Councilmember Hickman said the Volunteer Appreciation Reception was held prior to the City Council meeting to thank and recognize all of the people out there who serve on a City boards or commissions. Their services helps Norman be the great city it is.

Councilmember Wilson welcomed Councilmembers Scott and Carter. She said she and Councilmember Bierman have served one year and were welcomed by Kyle Allison and Aleisha Karjala and she really appreciated their mentorship. She said many times when someone runs for office, they engage in political dialogue and want to vilify people who have a different opinion than themselves. What she found to be true was that the councilmembers have a lot more in common than she realized and they were able to get a lot done because they worked together. She said every person on this Council cares about the community and might have different ways of getting the job done but they all care. She said she really looks forward to working with Councilmembers Carter and Scott.

Councilmember Clark welcomed the new Councilmembers. She said being a Councilmember is a lot of work but a labor of love. She said Aleisha and she served together on the Library Board before they were elected to Council. She said Aleisha's background of Political Science was invaluable, her commitment is unmatched, and she will be missed. She said she got to know Kyle better when the seating arrangement was changed. She said he did not talk a lot but when he did, it was always very thoughtful and she had been very impressed with him. She said she hopes as Council tackles some very important issues, we can do so respectfully and politely. She said a lot more would be accomplished when all Councilmembers respect one another throughout the process.

Councilmember Holman said he was sworn in five years ago and during that time he served with 17 different councilmembers. He said with Councilmembers Scott and Carter, that total has changed to 19. He said when he started he was 28 and the next youngest Councilmember at that time had been around 40 years old and two women were on the City Council. He said is it exciting to see how that has changed; a majority of women is on the City Council and half of the City Council is under the age of 35. He said the youngest Councilmember to serve on Council was sworn in tonight. He said he is looking forward to working with the new Councilmembers. He said he will miss Aleisha's perspective and talking with her about some of their commonalities. He said both he and Kyle went to Norman High School together and were on the track team, though Kyle is two years younger.
