We strongly support the application to add the 400 block of College Ave. to the Chautauqua Historic District. We have lived in our home at 423 Elm Ave. for over 20 years. We bought in the area because of the collection of historic eclectic homes. The recent destruction of historic homes in the core area motivated the residents of College Ave. and Elm/Park to seek downzoning from R-3 to R-1 in the hope of protecting and preserving our neighborhoods. Based on the continued destruction of older homes and trees, it has become evident that R-1 zoning alone will not preserve the character of our neighborhood.

The requests to save historic homes and the preservation of older neighborhoods can't be better said than by Bob Goins in his 1990 study. "Neighborhoods have a physical charm and texture that is rapidly disappearing and should be saved. In making these proposals to rezone to a lesser density, emphasis has been placed on conservation and restoration of these neighborhoods as environments of opportunities for homeowners-not to be viewed as areas or economic speculation by those who live somewhere else. Again, we strongly urge you to provide further protections for our neighborhood.




