AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER AS PROVIDED BY ARTICLE XVII, SECTION 1, OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NORMAN; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AS PROVIDED BY ARTICLE XII, SECTION 5 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NORMAN; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

- §1. WHEREAS, Section 1 of Article XVII of the Charter of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, provides that the City Council shall fix, by Ordinance, the compensation of the City Manager; and
- §2. WHEREAS, Contract No. K-1819-67 is being submitted to Council for consideration on September 25, 2018, to hired Mary Rupp to serve as the Interim City Manager for the City of Norman at the pleasure of the City Council; and
- §3. WHEREAS, Section 3 of Contract No. K-1819-67 provides for compensation to be set at a salary of nine thousand eight hundred dollars (\$9,800.00) per month, plus reasonable travel and lodging expenses, as approved by the Mayor; and
- §4. WHEREAS, Section 5 of Article XII of the Charter of the City of Norman, Oklahoma provides that if, in the judgment of the Council of the City of Norman, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, or safety of the citizens of Norman that this Ordinance become effective prior to the time an ordinary ordinance would become effective, then the Council may declare an emergency so that the ordinance will become effective immediately upon its passage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- §5. That the salary and compensation of the interim City Manager shall be and are hereby fixed at a salary of nine thousand eight hundred dollars (\$9,800.00) per month, plus reasonable travel and lodging expenses, as approved by the Mayor; and
- §6. That the effective date of the interim City Manager's Compensation under this Ordinance shall be September 28, 2019 consistent with Contract No. K-1819-67; and
- §7. <u>EMERGENCY SECTION</u> (requiring 2/3rd majority for passage to be voted on separately). That in the judgment of the Council of the City of Norman, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, or safety of the citizens of Norman that this Ordinance become effective prior to the time an ordinary ordinance would become effective, thereby declaring an emergency so that the ordinance will become effective immediately upon its passage.
