

A RESOLUTION OF THE TRUSTEES OF THE NORMAN MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY APPROPRIATING \$42,863 FROM THE SANITATION FUND BALANCE TO PURCHASE ONE (1) PICKUP TRUCK FOR THE SANITATION DIVISION TO REPLACE A TRUCK STOLEN FROM THE NORMAN TRANSFER STATION.

- § 1. WHEREAS, On December 2, 2018, thieves stole a 2005 Chevrolet one-half ton pickup (Unit 209) from the Transfer Station located at 3901 South Chautauqua Avenue and to date, it has not been recovered; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, this vehicle is used for operational purposes and the Fleet Division has determined a replacement cost of \$42,863; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the truck will be purchased using State of Oklahoma contracts whereby bidding has already occurred by City Code; and
