

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, ESTABLISHING AND
APPOINTING A CENSUS COMPLETE COUNT
COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT THE
2020 CENSUS PLAN OF ACTION FOR THE CITY OF
NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the United States Constitution requires a Census of the population of our nation every ten years; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, Census information is used to determine how many seats our state has in the United States House of Representatives and is also used to for redistricting our State Legislature, our City Council, and voting districts; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, having an accurate and complete Census Count is important to our community in determining Federal and State aids and grants, economic development, housing assistance, transportation improvements, and many other uses; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, every resident of our community counts and deserves to be counted and certain Norman citizens may be at risk of not being included because of background, education, socio-economic hardship or lack of information.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. That a Census Complete Count Committee be established to promote the Census to ensure that all residents of our community are counted.
- § 6. The Census Complete Count Committee will be charged with developing and implementing a 2020 Census outreach, promotion, recruiting, and enumeration assistance plan of action designed to target and address the needs of the community.
- § 7. The Census Complete County Committee will consist of ten members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council. The members to be appointed are Aisha Ali, Michelle Evans, Charles Hollingsworth, Aleisha Karjala, Otto Orellana, Kelly Sitzman, Darry Stacy, Laura Tontz, Rex Wall, and Meredith Wahpekeche.
