On Thursday, February 14, 2019, six bids from general contractors were received, opened, and publicly read at the Authority's office in Norman, Oklahoma for the above-referenced project. The base and alternate bids were as follows:

4.	BRB Contractors	\$ 3,651,520	\$ 4,065,485
5.	WEB Construction	\$ 3,802,108	\$ 4,231,727
6.	Cimarron Construction	\$ 4,103,915	\$ 4,480,400

Our final Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (OPCC) was \$3,304,750. The low bid of \$2,845,591.00 was submitted by Central Contracting Services. APAI did not identify any math errors in the six base and alternate bids identified in the table above.

Central Contracting Services has worked with the Authority previously and has extensive pipeline construction experience in Norman and throughout Oklahoma. APAI contacted references provided by Central Contracting Services and received positive feedback. Central's proposal also appears to be in order. Therefore, APAI recommends that the contract for construction of the Robinson Street Waterline Replacement Project be awarded to Central Contracting Services in the amount of \$2,845,591.00.
