Text of Legislative File O-1819-44

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BACKGROUND: Section 1 of Article XVII of the Charter of the City of Norman requires that the City Manager's compensation be fixed by Ordinance. Council is scheduled to approve an employment contract with Mr. Darrel Pyle (K-1819-146) on June 11, 2019.

DISCUSSION: This Ordinance codifies the compensation contained in Contract K-1819-146 and meets the Charter requirements. It sets forth the specific provisions for an annual base salary of \$170,000; an additional amount of 13% of the annual salary as deferred compensation; a one-time signing payment of \$5,000; \$6,000 annual automobile allowance payable in equal installments with payroll; \$1,200 annual cellular phone allowance payable in equal installations with payroll; standard employee retirement, health and dental benefits; term life insurance of \$200,000; and a City contribution to a qualified retirement account.

Mr. Pyle's start date is July 15, 2019. In order for the Ordinance to be effective on July 15, 2019, Council must adopt an emergency clause and an effective date.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends adoption of Ordinance O-1819-44 upon approval of Mr. Pyle's employment agreement.
