AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING SECTION 460 OF CHAPTER 22 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORMAN SO **REMOVE** LOT AS TO **SEVENTEEN** BLOCK SEVENTY- TWO (72), OF THE ORIGINAL TOWN OF NORMAN, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, FROM THE CCFBC, CENTER CITY FORM-BASED CODE, AND PLACE SAME IN THE CCPUD, CENTER CITY PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF. (230 WEST GRAY STREET)

- § 1. WHEREAS, MCD Wellness Society, L.L.C., with the permission of the owners, Goodman Holdings, L.L.C., have made application to have the subject property removed from the CCFBC, Center City Form-Based Code, and placed in the CCPUD, Center City Planned Unit Development; and

§ 4. That Section 460 of Chapter 22 of the Code of the City of Norman, Oklahoma, is hereby amended so as to remove the following described property from the CCFBC, Center City Form-Based Code, and place the same in the CCPUD, Center City Planned Unit Development, to wit:
