A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, APPROPRIATING \$12,860.37 FROM THE REFUNDS REIMBURSEMENTS MISCELLANEOUS RISK MANAGEMENT ACCOUNT RECEIVED FROM TRAFFIC SIGNALS, INC., TO REPLACE TRAFFIC SIGNAL EQUIPMENT DAMAGED DURING THE SITE WORK FOR A PROPOSED ONCUE TO BE LOCATED ON SOUTH CLASSEN BOULEVARD.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Control Division maintains more than 170 traffic city wide using \$105,291 in the Division's operating budget for the purchase of replacement traffic signal system components needed for safe and efficient operation; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, in August, 2019, damage was sustained to the traffic signal and battery back-up cabinets located at the OnCue construction site on Classen Boulevard at State Highway 9; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the signal contractor for the OnCue Project, Traffic Signals, Inc., has submitted full payment in the amount of \$12,860.37 for the damages which has been deposited into the Refunds/Reimbursements Miscellaneous Risk Management account; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, those funds need to be appropriated into the traffic signal parts account to be used for the purchase of new equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:
