

CONSIDERATION OF ORDINANCE O-2021-36: UPON FIRST, SECOND AND FINAL READING: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE XI, SECTION 1105 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA TO EXTEND THE PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED SUNSET DATE RELATED TO COVID-19 REGULATIONS FROM MARCH 1, 2021 TO JUNE 1, 2021; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 1. That, Section 11-1105 of Chapter 10 of the Code of the City of Norman, Oklahoma be amended as follows:

Sec. 11-1105. – Sunset.

This ordinance shall expire ~~on March 1~~ June 1, 2021, unless repealed or modified by the City Council through subsequent ordinance.

§ 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City, and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this Ordinance become operative immediately and therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval by the City Council.

§ 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
