MONTH OF APRIL 2021, AS NATIONAL

- § 3. WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has impacted our ability to gather for volunteering, we recognize nonprofits still have services to meet and citizens have needs to be met; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, National Volunteer Week 2021 will be honored on April 18-24, 2021, and individuals, schools, businesses, nonprofits, and every person are encouraged to take part in safe, social-distanced service; and
