# FINANCE COMMITTEE MINUTES March 18, 2021

### DISCUSSION REGARDING A CITY BUSINESS LICENSE

Kathryn Walker stated that it was requested that the idea of having a general business license be placed on the agenda again. Her intern did research on how it's done in other cities around Oklahoma, but Yukon is the only city that has a general business license. A general business license would not require an inspection and it would be an annual license. Having such a license would have helped during COVID-19, as it would have provided a better list of local businesses. If we were to implement such a license, we would probably offer it for \$25.

Walker stated that we would have to amend the business license ordinance to include general business licenses if the City Council decides to proceed. Mayor Clark stated that she hopes we could move forward with this quickly. If we move forward, we will require all businesses in Norman to purchase a general business license yearly.

He stated that this is the first of the period of uncertainty where we are comparing sales tax revenue to periods in which shopping behavior is being effected by COVID-19.
