SUBJECT: Claim from Delsia Kelsey (Including Minors)

I am in receipt of a claim from Delsia Kelsey, through her attorney, Carr and Carr, in the amount of \$30,643.50 for medical expenses for injuries sustained in an accident with a Compost Facility vehicle on September 21, 2020, at I-240 and Eastern in Oklahoma City. She is also including medical expenses for minor children, Mya Kelsey, in the amount of \$8,275.25, and Peyton Mueller in the amount of \$2,418.50. To our knowledge, no claim has been filed for vehicle damages.

On October 2, 2020, a claim from Terry Eitel in the amount of \$5,159.33 was filed for damages to his vehicle due to an accident with a City vehicle, driven by Louis Alvarez, Compost Facility employee, on September 21, 2020, at I-240 and Eastern in Oklahoma City. Mr. Eitel stated the City vehicle struck the vehicle behind him, which struck his vehicle.

Chris, I would appreciate your checking with your staff regarding verification of the problem. Please report your findings by written memorandum to me with a copy to Kathryn.

Kathryn, if it is determined the City has liability in this matter, please signify by writing a report of your recommendations in order that we may schedule this claim as an agenda item.
